Subject : Demands for Grants for the year 2014-15

Sir,

I am directed to say that the "Vote on Account" for the month of April, 2014 to September, 2014 has been voted by the Parliament and relevant "The Delhi Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2014 has also been assented to by the President of India. Hence the departments can incur expenditure out of Budget Estimates 2014-15 for the period April to September, 2014 subject to observance of prescribed procedure.

However, the expenditure during the period of vote on account should not exceed 1/2 (one half) of the total Budget Estimates 2014-15 of the Department. Since the "Vote on Account" includes one half of estimated provision for the whole year. Further, the provision therein is not to be used for expenditure on any "New Service/New Instrument of service".
